31.05 (2)(a) - COST OF PROGRAM

The total cost of Launch Academy's program is as follows:

31.05: (2)(b) - GRADUATION

48% of students graduated from the program from January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2019.

Graduation Rate is defined by the number of students who received certificates, diplomas, or degrees in the program during the latest two calendar years, divided by the number of students who enrolled in the program during the latest two calendar years. The graduation rate shall be determined within 180 days from the end of each calendar year.

31.05 (2)(c) - GRADUATION TIME

The average student completes virtual work (Ignition) in 8 weeks, and completes onsite instruction (On Campus) in 10 weeks.

31.05 (4)(b) - PLACEMENT RATES

86% of graduates from January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2019 obtained full-time, non-temporary jobs in their field of study. 42% of students that enrolled in the program during January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2019 obtained full-time, non-temporary jobs in their field of study.

Graduate Placement Rate is defined as the number of students obtaining full time (at least 32 hours per week) and non-temporary employment in the field of study during the latest two calendar years for which the school has obtained verification, divided by the number of all students graduating from the program during the latest two calendar years. The graduate placement rate shall be determined within 180 days from the end of each calendar year
